# Manfred Krüger (Göttingen)

Cinematographer, Göttingen

Manfred Krüger is a trained television and radio technician. Since thirty years he works as a cinematographer in Göttingen. He undertook various filming tours, e.g. to Irian Jaya, Sumatra, Borneo, Burkina Faso, Mexico, USA and India. Many of the film projects, in which he participated, evolved under the collaboration of the German Research Foundation (DFG). His filming work could be termed as ethnographic; he also realised some projects in collaboration with social anthropologists. In the course of his work Manfred Krüger won several documentary and scientific film prizes, e.g. at the Second ASTRA of Anthropological-Documentary Film in Sibiu, Romania, 1994 and the Bilan du film in Paris, France.

### Main Research and Ongoing Projects

Since 1976 Manfred Krüger holds lectures about ethnographic filming as well as about technical aspects of film work. His teaching work associated him with the German Cultural Institute in Istanbul, Turkey, the Yunnan University in Kunming, China and with Bhila, India. He further taught at the University of Frankfurt/Oder, Germany.
